## Ways to Calculate Total Annual Income

**Use past month (30 days) check stubs for income verification**

**Gross Income:** Most recent IRS 1040 (Net Income for Farm and Self-Employed workers)

**YTD:** Divided by # weeks paid x 52 weeks

**Weekly** x 52 weeks

**Every 2 weeks** x 26 weeks

**2 Checks per month** 1 pay stub x 24

**Monthly** x 12 months

**No Income:** Review "No Income" questions to determine if part of another family. If not, record \$0 annual income. Record Self-Declared/ Verification.

**Adjunct Eligibility** (Medicaid, Food Stamps or FIP): Verify current eligibility. Then client can self-declare income.

**Sudden Change in Income:**

**Remember!** You can use 1040 tax with W-2 forms until the next one is filed for documentation.
